Officer Reports:

President

1. Shout out to Beth and Kristen for a great job with the craft fair

Vice President - absent

Treasurer

1. Updated P&L distributed. Numbers do not include craft fair - brought in about \$17,600
2. We have 2 bank accounts - 1 at Severn, which is where the line of credit is and we will run all Weight Room revenue through them. BB&T changing name to Truist Bank

Committee Chair Reports

Craft Fair

1. Craft fair went well. A lot of positive feedback
2. Brought in about \$17,600
3. Parking went well this year. A thank you to the student leadership organization for their help
4. A few issues to address for next year:

- a. Lighting in cafeteria - a lot of bulbs out
- b. Wrestling mat - will not put vendors under that again

Membership

1. Boys basketball has the highest % at 70% and wrestling the lowest at 37.8%
2. Memberships are still coming in and hope to have all teams over 60%

Merchandise

1. Charity to continue to handle the merchandise. Christiana stepping down as she does not have the time and can no longer handle it.
2. Looking for replacement
3. Charity discussed needing a better way to handle payment. Charity made a motion to purchase an Amazon Fire and Paypal secure swiper, Kath seconded the motion

Weight Room Update - Coach Necessary and Rich Bowen

1. Coach Necessary and Rich Bowen met with Board of Ed last week and unanimously approved Boosters funding a new weight room
2. EnerG Wellness to be a sponsor for the weight room with a donation
3. 25% deposit will come out of current funds before going into the line of credit
4. Funding of \$200,000
 - a. Kath Murphy to call on current sponsors first (Coach Necessary to contact Clear Shark as he is personal friends with them). This is to be done in December
 - b. In January, we will send a letter to all Booster families for financial support
 - c. Also need to ask local PT organizations.
 - d. Possible "Text to Give" campaign discussed
 - i. Incentives for the kids to get coaches, principal to shave head, dye hair maroon, etc.
 - e. FYI - Principal Todd not comfortable sending out a Connect Ed for donations
 - f. Email through Family ID to go out in January
 - g. Kath to get list from Melissa Quigley of vendors from the Health and Wellness event held at BHS
 - h. Melissa Bowen to send letter to lacrosse alumni - Kath to email to her
5. Bull Roast??
 - a. Kath checked Columbian Center and Earleigh Heights. Low availability and costly. Elks Lodge was mentioned, and possibly move event to May
6. Coach Necessary met with Mr. Torggler with EnerG Wellness to come up with a plan
 - a. Room to be painted and ready by Feb 1 to lay flooring, could be closer to mid-February
 - b. Christiana Walsh with County to plan to get all equipment out of room and offer to other schools first, we can not sell out equipment
 - c. Ms. Lemon will get a dumpster for flooring
 - d. Would like to have whole project complete by April 1
 - e. Need to have at least \$100,000 in fundraising completed by April 15

7. Bob Stillwell donating labor for fixtures. Replacing 15 fixtures, clean up wiring.
8. County has already come to fix holes in walls
9. We will need to get whiteboards down, county will take out watercooler
10. Kath Murphy to keep master spreadsheet of all donors to the weight room

Athletic Department - Coach Necessary

1. Passed on a thank you from Lanell Smith for Boosters support of the girls volleyball team.
2. January 3rd will be the Coach Kaz celebration between the Varsity girls and boys home game. Should be around 20-30 minutes with 4 speakers - Principal Todd, Clayton Culp, Eric Elston and Mr. McMullen
3. We have an 8x10 whole gymnasium picture to present
4. Citation and resolution from general assembly will be presented
5. Donnelly's Dockside has reserved the lower level at 9PM - will have "victory" and "losers" platters - cost will be around \$200 - Rich made a motion for Boosters to pay for this and Charity seconded it.
6. There will be a meet and greet before the game with cookies and water
7. Flyer will go on website and Sean Tettemer to put on Facebook and social media
8. 1200 tickets max - will reserve seats for Coach Kaz's family, wife, Jill to make a collage and Dennis McGinley to take photos
9. Court cost was a total of \$2,499.11 - previously voted on Boosters paying
10. Senior Athletic Award Banquet to be held on Monday, May 18 at BEP Church. We need to pay custodians and tech person - Rich made a motion to pay for these costs totally \$200 and Stephany seconded.
